## Holy Thursday April 17<sup>th</sup>

Liturgy of the Lord's Supper.....7:00 p.m.

On Holy Thursday, we hear Christ's mandate to love one another, and so have the washing of the feet and bring our gifts of food for the Food Box Program. We end our liturgy with a Eucharistic procession into the candlelit garden in the Community Building, which will be open for Adoration until 11:00 p.m.

## Good Friday April 18<sup>th</sup>

Liturgy of the Hours I.....Noon - 12:30

Liturgy of the Lord's Passion.....12:30 - 2 p.m.

During which we will experience the Passion of our Lord, reverence the cross, bear its weight as a community, and gather around it in prayer.

Liturgy of the Hours II.....2:00-3:00 pm

## Holy Saturday April 19<sup>th</sup>

Easter Vigil .....8:30 p.m.

The Paschal fire is lit, the Catechumens are baptized and Confirmed and then celebrate their first Communion. Reception follows after the Mass.  
**(Please note: There is no 5 p.m. Mass on April 19<sup>th</sup>.)**

## Easter Sunday April 20<sup>th</sup>

Adult Masses.....7am & 11:30 am  
Children/Families.....8:30 & 10:00 am

The 8:30 a.m. Mass is usually a little less crowded than the 10 a.m. Mass, but please remember to come early for all the Masses to find a seat. All are welcome.

**Please note:** There will be no 6 pm Mass on Easter Sunday.
